El Paso County ESD No. 1 puts Heavy Rescue to use

HORIZON CITY - El Paso County Emergency Services District #1 (ESD #1) rescue team got an opportunity to use their skills and equipment recently. They, along with members from COMSAR and Montana Vista Fire stations, extracted a man from atop a mountain peak in the Hueco Tanks Mountains. The individual needing help had broken his leg and delivery of the new heavy rescue truck couldn't walk. He was eventually carried down by the rescue team.

The quick action by the firefighters in the recent mountain rescue is credited largely to the various equipment that is incorporated into ESD #1's newest truck - the Heavy Rescue. The truck is housed in ESD #1's Fire Station in Horizon City.

"All of the equipment that we used in that rescue came off of our truck," stated Ron Larson, administrator, firefighter, and emergency medical technician for El Paso County's ESD #1.

Volunteers needed for tax preparation

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


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

Driving ambition

A British team seeks to set new land speed records with a car they say can travel at 1,000 miles an hour. An earlier version of the vehicle already holds the world record of 763 miles per hour set in 1997. The new Bloodhound SSC [supersonic car] is powered by a jet engine rated at 133,151 horsepower, reports the Association of Mature American Citizens. The speed demons plan to first break the existing record by accelerating their car to some 800 mph in a trial slated to take place in South Africa next spring. Later they'll attempt to reach their goal of traveling at 1,000 mph or more – a rate of speed that, if it was possible to sustain, could get them from New York to Los Angeles in less than three hours.



Wanted

A man has robbed at least two convenience stores at knifepoint, in El Paso's Mission Valley, and ordered the employees to the ground. Detectives are asking for the public's assistance in identifying this armed robber, through the Crime Stoppers. Both robberies took place in El Paso's Mission Valley and within blocks of each other. On Sunday, Oct. 4, 2015 at 4:34 a.m., a man walked into the Seven Eleven store located at 7400 Alameda. The man walked in, covering his face with a white shirt, and holding a large knife. The man immediately ordered the store clerk to the ground and demanded money from the register. The man fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of cash. He was last seen walking westbound on Alameda. Almost a week later on Saturday, Oct. 10, 2015 the same suspect walked into another Seven Eleven located at 7150 Alameda at 2:49 a.m. In this case suspect entered the store with a bandana covering his face. The suspect walked behind the counter and with a knife ordered the clerk to the ground and demanded money from the register. The suspect fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect is described as a White or Hispanic male, average height, about 180 pounds. He is believed to be in his mid 20s. In both cases he used something to cover his face and is wearing tennis shoes. 
