House Bill 25 removes option for straight-ticket vote from Texas ballots

TEXAS – Texas voters will no longer have the straight-ticket option to vote for an entire party's slate. Under House Bill 25 that was signed recently by Governor Greg Abbott, the new law will eliminate the straight-ticket voting option starting in September 2020.

Straight-ticket voting, the option for voters to check one box to cast a ballot for every candidate from a single political party, accounted for nearly 64 percent of total votes cast in Texas' 10 largest counties in the 2016 general election.

Supporters of the bill say removing the option will force voters to make more informed decisions in individual elections, but opponents say the legislation will disproportionately impact minority voters.

• On July 10, 1962, the United States Patent Office issues Swedish engineer Nils Bohlin a patent for his three-point automobile safety belt. The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 made seat belts mandatory on all new American vehicles from the 1968 model year onward.

• On July 11, 1804, Vice President Aaron Burr fatally shoots his long-time political antagonist Alexander Hamilton in a duel. Charged with murder in New York and New Jersey, Burr, still the vice president, returned to Washington, D.C., where he finished his term immune from prosecution.

 On July 12, 1957, Dwight Eisenhower becomes the first president to ride in a helicopter. Although helicopters had been tested since 1947, it was not until 10 years later that a president considered using the new machine for short, official trips to and from the White House.

• On July 13, 1978, Ford Motor Company chairman Henry Ford II fires Lee lacocca as Ford's president. The following year, lacocca was hired as president of the nearly bankrupt Chrysler Corporation, which ended up getting a \$1.5 billion bailout from Congress.

• On July 14, 1789, Parisian revolutionaries and mutinous troops storm and dismantle the Bastille, signaling the start of the French Revolution. The royal fortress had come to symbolize the tyranny of the Bourbon monarchs.

• On July 15, 2002, John Walker Lindh, the "American Taliban," accepts a pleabargain deal and pleads guilty to one count of supplying services to the Taliban and carrying weapons. Lindh






