### Soccer fans

With 32 countries getting ready to kickin' it in the World Cup in Russia, the personal-finance website WalletHub has released its report on 2018's Best Cities for Soccer Fans. To find the best places for loving on the world's favorite sport, WalletHub compared nearly 300 U.S. cities with at least one college or professional soccer team across six divisions comprising 63 key metrics. The data set ranges from minimum season-ticket price for a game to stadium accessibility to number of championship wins. El Paso ranked 53rd among large cities:

- For MLS, Dallas FC' performance level, 45.10 percent, is 1.5 times better than Minnesota United FC's, 29.41 percent.
- For NWSL, Portland Thorns FC's performance level, 49.44 percent, is 1.7 times better than the Houston Dash's, 29.72 percent.
- For NASL, Miami FC' performance level, 48.44 percent, is 1.9 times better than Jacksonville Armada FC's, 25.56 percent.
- Orlando, Fla., has the lowest minimum season-ticket price for an MLS game, \$144, which is 3.9 times less expensive than in New York, the city with the highest at \$562.
- Cary, N.C., has the lowest minimum

# Thousands join protest in Tornillo

TORNILLO - In the heart of El Paso County's lower valley lush, green cotton and pecan fields, over two thousand individuals joined in solidarity to send a message to America.

Concerned citizens drove for several miles, parked their vehicles along both sides of the highway that leads to the Marcelino Serna Tornillo Port of Entry and walked together to the bridge's entrance.

On that sunny, warm Sunday morning, Fathers Day, people from across the region and other parts of the country gathered around U.S. Rep. Beto O'Rourke, D-El Paso, as he led the protest against the separation of immigrant families.

Using a megaphone at times, O'Rourke stated that he wanted to make sure that everyone in this country knows what is happening here in Tornillo, a rural border town about 40 miles from downtown El Paso.

"Kids, who have traveled 2,000 miles - some alone, some with their parents are now being held in detention camps, tent cities that have just been constructed over the course of this last week," the congressman said.

O'Rourke stated, "This is a decision for the country to make. Either we are going to be a country of detention camps for kids, of walls, of sending the National Guard to the border, or are we going to be better than that. It's not decided by any means, and though we've been able to figure it out in the past, doesn't mean we're going to figure it out this time. It's on us. No one is going to do this for us.

"So, the people of El Paso, the people of the border, the people from the surrounding regions, the people who have driven in from even further, are going to be the ones that decide this thing.

"I'm lucky enough to be able to join everyone who's made the decision to be here. This is a community effort," O'Rourke claimed.

O'Rourke warned, "It's not on the Republicans... This isn't on a political party. I wouldn't even say this is on this administration, although this administration has carried it to its most inhumane, logical conclusion. But, we have been ignoring this immigration issue, or perpetuating it, for many years and many administrations right now. This has got to be on us to get it right. I think it's going to be on us, the people of the border, who do that.

"If there's ever been a time to be from El Paso, from the border, to share our perspective, it's right now, it's at this moment. So, I just could not be more joined by former El Paso County Judge



wanted to work with students at a different capacity. One of her greatest accomplishments as head counselor has been incorporating the ASCA datadriven program at her campus.







- On July 2, 1992, the 1 millionth Corvette, a white LT1 roadster with a red interior and a black roof the same colors as the original 1953 model rolls off the assembly line in Bowling Green, Kentucky.
- On July 3, 1863, on the third day of the Battle of Gettysburg, Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee's last attempt at breaking the Union line ends in disastrous failure, bringing the most decisive battle of the American Civil War to an end. The tally: 23,000 killed, wounded or missing Union soldiers. The Confederates suffered some 25,000 casualties.
- On July 4, 1919, challenger Jack Dempsey defeats heavyweight champion Jess Willard in searing 110-degree heat in Toledo, Ohio, to win the heavyweight championship of the world. "The Manassa Mauler" bested Willard in 10 minutes.
- On July 5, 1975, although seemingly past his prime, Arthur Ashe defeats a heavily favored Jimmy Connors to become the first black man ever to win Wimbledon, the most coveted championship in tennis.
- On July 6, 1933, Major League Baseball's first All-Star Game takes place at Chicago's Comiskey Park. The event was designed to bolster the sport and improve its reputation during the darkest days of the Great Depression.
- On July 7, 1797, for the first time in U.S. history, the House of Representatives votes to impeach a federal officer. Sen. William Blount of Tennessee was charged with "a high misdemeanor" for entering into a conspiracy with British officers to enlist frontiersmen and Cherokee Indians to aid the British.
- On July 8, 1950, Gen. Douglas MacArthur, the hero of the war against Japan, is appointed head of the United Nations Command by President Harry Truman. Truman fired MacArthur nine months later after he defied the president and threatened to escalate hostilities with China.

# Was son right to ignore his doctor's advice?

DEAR DR. ROACH: My son is 40 years old. After a recent stress test, he ended up with five stents in his arteries, and also was diagnosed with diabetes. His doctor ordered him not

to go back to work for three or four weeks, but he went back after three days. He told the doctor that he would be more stressed if he stayed home. His job is mostly sitting down. Since he didn't follow the advice, how will this affect  $his\ health? - V.B.$ 



We don't normally have people stay home for long

periods of time after placement of stents, so I was surprised to hear that he was "ordered" (I almost never "order," only recommend, more or less strongly) to stay home.

My experience is that after receiving life-changing diagnoses, such as diabetes or coronary artery disease, it's best to keep some habits, such as work, the same and change others. For your son, I am sure he will be recommended a proper diet for diabetes and exercise appropriate for a person with a new diagnosis of heart disease.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I've suffered from essential tremor for 16 years. I take 500 mg of primidone and 40 mg of propranolol twice daily. I've gradually increased the dose over the years, and the combination works quite well. What is the highest dose of these medications that I can take? Also, are there any new drugs on the market that have been proven to help? -S.S.

Primidone, a medication indicated for seizures, often is used off-label for essential tremor. The normal dose for essential tremor is 250-500 mg at night, but doses up to 750 mg sometimes are used. For seizures, the highest recommended dose is 2,000 mg, so although yours is at the high end of normal for essential tremor ("essential," by the way, simply means we don't know what is causing it; it isn't essential for anything), you still are at a dose that's well below the safe limit. I suspect that because you have been on it for so long, your body is used to this dose. The usual starting dose is 25 mg.

Propranolol is used for many conditions, including high blood pressure and preventing migraines, but its use in essential tremor also is off-label, meaning that the Food and Drug Administration has not approved the drug for use for this condition. "Off-label" doesn't necessarily mean your prescription is wrong or dangerous,

# Reducing suicide risk

The number is almost as bad as it used to be: 20 veterans commit suicide each day, down from a previous 22. That number still is much too high. True to his word, however, President Donald Trump has signed an Executive Order directing more supportive mental health care for service members who are now transitioning to veteran status.

agencies work together on this: the Departments of Veterans Affairs, of Defense and of Homeland Security.

The target time for support and intervention is in that first year, with the stress of separating from the service and moving into civilianlife. Some of those stresses include finances, relationships, legal concerns and substance abuse. One big problem has been that signs and symptoms haven't appeared until after the transition to civilian life.

Sixteen steps are planned, such as expanding community

outreach from 18 facilities to all of them, and extending Be There Peer Support Call and Outreach Center services for a whole year after separation. Military One Source resources to active-duty members will be expanded and include services for one year after separation. In addition, all separating service members will receive a mentalhealth screening; those who need care and support will be enrolled in services. Peer Support will include phone calls at specified intervals during the first year, with an initial goal to reach 60 percent of veterans.

If you're about to separate or recently did, and you get a phone call, heads up. Pay attention not only for yourself but to gather information for other veterans you might know. Listen to what they say about the Easy Button (a fast track for mental health appointments and care), the improved monitoring and resources, and the seamless access to treatment for mental health and suicide prevention.


