College debt

With college students going back to school and 10.7 percent of all student loans 90+ days delinquent or in default as of Q1 2018, the personal-finance website WalletHub has released its report on 2018's States with the Most and Least Student Debt. To determine the states that are friendliest toward student-loan debtors, WalletHub compared the 50 states and the District of Columbia across 11 key metrics. The data set ranges from average student debt to unemployment rate among the population aged 25 to 34 to share of students with past-due loan balances. Texas was 35th in the study, ranking:

- 38th Avg. Student Debt;
- 31st Proportion of Students with
- 24th Student Debt as % of Income (Adjusted for Cost of Living);
- 27th Unemployment Rate of Population Aged 25 to 34;
- 23rd % of Student Loans Past Due or in Default;
- 35th % of Student-Loan Borrowers
- Aged 50+; • 24th – Availability of Student Jobs;
- 31st Availability of Paid Internships; and
- 12th Grant Growth.

Tornillo shelter to stay open another 30 days

TORNILLO About unaccompanied minors are still being housed in tent structures at the Marcelino Serna Tornillo Port of Entry in Tornillo, Cesar Blanco.

Blanco and five other members of the Mexican American Legislative Caucus of the Texas House visited the facility recently to meet with federal officials and leaders from BCFS, the San Antoniobased nonprofit currently running day-today operations. Touring the site along with Rep. Blanco were State Representatives Diego Bernal, Mary Gonzalez, Ina Minjarez, Eddie Rodriguez, and Gina Hinojosa.

The temporary tent shelters for immigrant children at the Tornillo port of entry will stay open for at least another month at their current capacity, Blanco

related.

The facility was scheduled to close on Monday, August 13, the date when the federal government's latest contract with BCFS was slated to expire. But a spokesperson with the Department Health and Human Services Administration for Children and Families Texas, according to State Representative in a public statement indicated that the government would continue operations in Tornillo for an additional 30 days, setting the new closing date for September 13.

> Blanco stated that officials at the Tornillo facility told lawmakers on tour that there are no plans to accept 4,000 additional minors at the shelter as initially reported. The original request for a contractor to operate the shelter included the possibility of increasing the capacity to as many as 4,000 beds; but, so far, the shelter, which opened with 400 available beds, has not increased its capacity, according to officials.

> The tent structures at the port of entry were erected in June to serve as temporary

housing for minors apprehended crossing the border alone and those who were separated from their parents under the Trump administration's zero tolerance immigration policy.

The minors who are still living at the shelter are boys between the ages of 13 and 17, who were apprehended crossing the border without an adult, Blanco stated. The shelter once had as many as 326 children, including girls and children separated from their parents at the border.

State Representative González, who is from Clint, criticized the lack of transparency in the current process for operating the shelter. "This is happening every 30 days," she said at the recent press conference after meeting with officials at the shelter. "The lack of transparency, the lack of a process really makes it difficult for advocates and policymakers to make decisions. If it changes every 30 days, if it's for 400 or 4,000- that's a big difference," Gonzalez asserted.



The Tornillo Independent School District provides the following educational services/ options to identified students with diabilities who reside within the district.

- ♦ Child find activities to notify students with disabilities and their parents of their rights and the district's obligation to provide a free, appropriate public education.
- ◆ Referrals to Sections 504 when it is believed the students have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities and the students are in need of educational accommodations.
- ♦ Procedural safeguards under Section 504.
- ♦ Evaluations of students to determine eligibility for the Section 504 program.
- ♦ Placement into the Section 504 program, which means the student may receive:
 - ✓ individually planned modifications in the regular classroom,
 - ✓ health services from the school nurse,
 - ✓ accommodations regarding access to any part of the campus, or
- ✓ assistance in reading for students with dyslexia in a reading program which meets the state's standards for a dyslexia reading program.



leadership has resulted in measurable results."

Smith was selected for this competitive award out of nominees submitted from all 50 community colleges across Texas. - On Sept. 8, the Recording Industry Association of America begins suing individual sharers of copyrighted mp3 some of whom are children. In the first 20 months, the RIAA sued over 11,000 people.
- On Sept. 9, 1967, Sgt. Duane D. Hackney is presented with the Air Force Cross for bravery in rescuing a USAF pilot in Vietnam. He was the first living Air Force enlisted man to receive the award.


Heading soccer ball puts youths at risk

DEAR DR. ROACH: Can "heading" the ball in soccer cause a concussion? I have grandchildren who play soccer, and I am concerned. - G.W.H.

The evidence is mounting that repeated trauma to the brain can contribute to a type of brain injury called chronic traumatic

encephalopathy, which seen frequently in boxers and football players. However, there is more and more evidence that soccer players also may get this injury, and it correlates to the number of headers players do.

Since younger brains may be more susceptible to injuries, and kids have relatively larger heads and weaker necks than



adults, the Sports Legacy Institute recommends against heading the ball until the age of 14.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 75-year-old woman with a lot of hot flashes. I heard that maca root is good for treating these. I have been taking it for two years, and feel like it has really helped me. Is this safe? -J.F.

Maca root, a dietary staple in Peru, has been touted as a treatment for both sexual performance and menopausal symptoms. One review found limited evidence for benefit in sexual function, but I could not find any study looking at its effectiveness in menopausal symptoms. Fortunately, it has few, if any, adverse effects and might be worth a try for those who haven't had benefit from or can't take other treatments. I have to remind you again that you may not be getting what you think you are buying, as oversight on supplements is limited.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I was diagnosed with peripheral artery disease in 1991. What kind of test is recommended for checking up on this? Can it be cured? – J.C.

"Peripheral artery disease" is the general term used for cholesterol plaques in the arteries, which can block blood flow. The most common symptom is pain with walking, usually after a specific exercise duration, which is relieved with rest. However, since these blockages can occur in any artery, PAD can cause many different symptoms, such as pain after eating (when the blockages are in the arteries to the gut). The disease most commonly is diagnosed by noninvasive studies, like a Doppler ultrasound of the arteries or using one blood pressure cuff on
