## Great training

Educators from Northwest Early College High School (NWECHS) in Canutillo ISD are among the best trained in all of the United States thanks to their successful completion of the National Board Certification process. On December 1, Michelle Belli, NWECHS counselor, was notified that she earned her National Board Certification for School Counseling. There are only 11 counselors in the state of Texas to earn the certification; Belli will be the first counselor in the region to earn this certification. In addition, the following teachers earned their National Board Certification: Catherine Tabor (math), Alisia Muir (English) and Berenice Sotelo (math). In all, Canutillo ISD has 10 of the 16 certified educators in Texas. "The National Board Certification will help us further address the needs of students," said Northwest Principal Tracy Speaker Gerstheimer. "Northwest already offers rigorous and challenging coursework. Now, we will be able to supplement what we already do with researchbased instruction that is of the highest caliber." National Board Certification is a voluntary, advanced credential that goes beyond state licensure. Participants must meet national standards for what accomplished teachers and counselors should know and be able to do. The process is rigorous and takes one to two years to complete. Participation in the process provides experienced educators with an opportunity to hone their practice, showcase their knowledge and demonstrate their dedication to students.

• Hurshel Antwine Elementary School will transition into a middle school for the

• Paso del Norte K-8 School will become an elementary school for the El Dorado feeder pattern.

• Sgt. Roberto Ituarte Elementary School will be the pre-k hub school in the El Dorado feeder pattern.

• The new SISD elementary school, Cactus Trails Elementary School (PK-5), will serve students that currently go to James P. Butler and Chester E. Jordan elementary schools.



census can manipulate the newly-drawn election maps to favor their party's candidates, typically drawing a majority of "safe" or noncompetitive seats. The elected officials in these districts can then no longer be held accountable through the power of our vote," Ackerman stated. "The League therefore supports reform that would place limits on partisanship and increase public participation in the redistricting process," she added.

LWV is a non-partisan organization that includes both men and women supporting issues but not candidates and parties. "We are particularly concerned about government, citizen participation, and areas of concern relating to social and health matters, education, the environment, and international affairs," Ackerman stated.

ACLU-TX is the leading civil rights organization in the Lone Star State. "Since our formation in 1938, we have worked in the courts, the legislature, and through public education to protect civil rights and individual liberty," according to officials.

Other organizations supporting the call for fair re-districting action are: Common Cause Texas, Common Ground for Texans, Clean Elections Texas, Texas Civil Rights Project, Texas Progressive Action Network, Texas Progressive Interest Research Group, Texans Against Gerrymandering, and VocesTejas.



## Gomez runs in prestigious meet

SAN ELIZARIO - San Elizario High School's Edwin Gomez, a sophomore, recently participated in one of the most important Cross Country races in the nation - the Nike Cross Nationals (NXN)

Championship. The race was held in Portland, Oregon where 210 elite runners from all over the country competed for the top spot in the national rankings.

Before qualifying for the NXN Meet, Gomez competed in the Nike Cross Regional (NXR) South Meet in The Woodlands, Texas. Out of 350 runners, Gomez came in 5th place, securing him a place in the national competition.

"The NXR South was not an easy race," said Cesar Morales, Head Coach for Cross Country at San Elizario High School (SEHS). "His top 5th finish is a result of his hard work, dedication, and respect to the sport. I had a feeling he was going to do well at the NXR South Meet and advance to the Nike national meet. He is a fighter who does not give up easily."

Competing at a national level is something Gomez never imagined would happen this early in his high school years. For him, this was an experience he will always remember.

"I did not know what to expect at all,"

Gomez said. "When I ran at the NXR South, I gave it my all but I never thought I would move on to the next level. Both races were tough, but to me it was not about placing a high rank. It was more about the experience and getting to meet and network with other top athletes from across the nation. To me, that was a real privilege."

Jorge Maese, Assistant Coach for Cross Country at SEHS, says he could not be more proud of Gomez and his accomplishments.

"Edwin's hard work has truly paid off and we are all extremely proud of him for making it this far," Maese said. "The NXN Meet was an eye-opener for Edwin and us as his coaches because it showed us what we need to do as a team and as a program to get to that level of competitiveness. We have a lot of work to do, but nothing is impossible."

Gomez finished 84th out of 210 national qualifiers and is the second individual qualifier to represent the El Paso region at the NXN Meet.

> Though Pitt won their half of the ACC, they still come into the game with a lackluster 7-6 record. Stanford finished 8-4; not a bad record but the Cardinal were ranked 13th in the AP preseason poll, and are always considered a potential top-10 team.

Pitt had big wins over Georgia Tech and Syracuse, but their best game of the year actually came in defeat. The Panthers were the closest to giving undefeated Notre Dame their only loss of the season.

The Fighting Irish scored a touchdown with just over five minutes left in the game to eke out a 19-14 win.

But Pitt was also smacked by teams like Penn State (51-6), UCF (45-14), Miami (24-3) and Clemson (42-10).

Stanford on the other hand, started the season 4-0 and were ranked #7 in the nation going into their big game at 4-0 Notre Dame.

Stanford was manhandled by the Irish 38-17 and finished their final eight games with a 4-4 record.

Stanford's biggest victory was their 38-31 overtime win at Oregon.

Over the last decade the Hyundai Sun Bowl has hosted loaded teams like Oklahoma, Virginia Tech, UCLA, Washington State, Miami, USC and even Notre Dame.

This year's matchup doesn't exactly bring the same hype as those games did, but that will happen from time to time.

The marquee names aren't here. And even the one preseason Heisman Trophy candidate in this game had a disappointing season.

Remember a couple years ago when Christian McCaffrey decided not to play in the Sun Bowl game for Stanford, his backup got the chance to run the football.

And run he did; Bryce Love landed in the national spotlight by rushing for 119 yards and catching a 49-yard touchdown pass.

Love has battled some injuries this season and missed a couple games. But still struggled to average only 73.9 yards per game.

The one offensive star in the game could be Stanford wide receiver JJ Arcega-Whiteside, who caught 60 passes for 969 yards and 14 touchdowns.

The best thing about the 2018 Hyundai Sun Bowl will be the contrasting styles of the two teams.

Pitt is ranked 18th in the nation in Neither team is ranked in the Top-25 rushing and has two running backs that gained over 1,000 yards.

> Senior running backs Qadree Ollison (1,190 yards and 11 touchdowns) and Darrin Hall (1,021 yards and nine touchdowns) lead a Panthers rushing attack that averages nearly 230 yards a game.

> Stanford quarterback K.J. Costello threw for 3,435 yards and 29 touchdowns this season.

> While the Cardinal are only averaging 108 yards rushing a game, they do throw the ball for 287 yards a game.

What could also make this an interesting game is the fact that neither defense has been exactly what you would call "stubborn" this season.

Pitt has allowed at least 30 points on six occasions this year while Stanford's D has allowed its opponents to top 30 in five games.

So although there aren't any well-known offensive superstars in this game, it could turn out to be an exciting high-scoring affair because of the shaky defenses.

But then again, any well-known offensive superstars would probably take the game off in anticipation of the NFL draft.

So Pitt and Stanford are getting together on New Year's Eve afternoon in El Paso; and about 40,000 locals will make the annual trek to the Sun Bowl stadium in support of the biggest event the city has to offer.

Let's just hope these two teams can pay back the local and national fans, by putting on a great show.




## Strange 'pimples' are rare disease

DEAR DR. ROACH: After having several strange-looking "pimples" on my thighs and one on my face, I was told it is lymphomatoid papulosis. One or two people in a million are diagnosed with this. I know that it is not contagious, but what is it? What causes it, how is it treated, and what can I do to

avoid these? They take weeks to heal. -R.R.

Lymphomatoid papulosis is a rare disease. It is in the category of cutaneous lymphoproliferative disorders. It is a chronic disease, and lasts years or even decades. The underlying cause is not known exactly, but it is related in many ways to



other lymphoproliferative diseases, such as mycosis fungoides and Hodgkin's lymphoma. The cells of the skin lesions you notice have similar genetic rearrangements as lymphoma cells. Fortunately, LyP has an excellent prognosis, although people with LyP are at increased risk for developing one of these serious conditions.

The papules of LyP can appear on the extremities or the hands and face, and less commonly on other places on the body. They may start off as small red papules, get larger and then crust over. Often, several exist at different stages.

Diagnosis may not be easy, as it takes an experienced dermatopathologist (pathologist with special training in skin diseases) and enough tissue to look at the genetics of the cells. Treatment is not necessary for every person with LyP. But for those who do require it, one might be ultraviolet-light treatment. More severe cases may require methotrexate, but this needs to be managed by an expert.

Experts have recommended six-month visits to evaluate for early signs of enlarging lymph nodes, which might indicate the development of a lymphoproliferative disorder.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I would like your opinion, as a noninterested party, on laser therapy. I see many ads touting its advantages and success in treating bone-on-bone knee osteoarthritis. My orthopedic doctor recommended knee replacements on both my knees. I had arthroscopic surgery on the left knee four years ago and was recommended total knee replacement on the right knee about three years ago. How long can I put off surgery, and what is the outlook if I don't have it done? I am an 80-year-old female in good health, except for the osteoarthritis. I use naproxen when needed. If it works, I think


