Commissioners review Ascarate Park improvements

EL PASO COUNTY – Although El Paso County Commissioners recently approved a fiscal budget for next year that leaves very little wiggle room for spending besides deficit reduction, basic services and unfunded state mandates, one thing for certain is cleaning up El Paso County's Ascarate Lake and beautifying its lakeshore remain goals supported by everyone who has a vested interest in the 48-acre body of water.

Ascarate Lake, which lies in the county's south-central region about a quarter mile from the Rio Grande, is nearly one-eighth of Ascarate Park's 400 acres, and for most visitors the lake is the park's central attraction. It is frequented by fishing enthusiasts, boaters, walkers, joggers, and individuals who just want to enjoy a family picnic next to a body of water.

The shared vision that county officials have put forward is to improve the park are things like improving the lake's water quality to promote healthier fish populations and creating safer recreation opportunities throughout the park.

"This body of water is unique... From the best fishing in the area to a boardwalk and boat dock. Visitors can enjoy recreational activities, go for a walk around the lake and view the varieties of birds, or just rest under the shade of a tree," commented David Stout, El Paso County Commissioner whose Precinct 2 encompasses the park.

But the lake faces serious challenges, the commissioner acknowledged. Persistent problems

like water loss, algae blooms, and sediment issues with the lake, including the golden algae buildup threaten the lake's beauty, water quality, and aquatic life. Furthermore, he stated that the sediment accumulation in specific locations in the banks need shoring up, and the overall lakeshore needs improving.

To address these issues, the County committed \$6 million in 2023 and hired a consulting firm, AECOM, to investigate conditions and options in more detail. Subsequently, the firm came up with a framework for action, and county officials recently held a public meeting to explain the conditions and options and to begin a community a final plan before the end of the year, with work would be caused by dredging and severely disrupt beginning early next year.

The AECOM study identified ways to address

bloom that kills fish and harms wildlife and lake. Based on those recommendations, county officials concluded that dredging the lake's bottom is not a guaranteed solution.

The study indicated that while it may seem like a straightforward fix, dredging would not address the root causes of algae blooms, such as nutrient runoff and temperature changes. Without addressing these underlying issues, algae will likely continue to return, the consultants concluded. 

aquatic habitats, displace wildlife, and negatively affect water quality during and after the process. They determined that given the ecological sensitivity biodiversity is a priority.

The consultants found that the expected and that the debris and sediment accumulation is only about significant as originally believed. "This finding reduces the need for large-scale dredging and allows the County to focus on more sustainable improvement options," Stout pointed out.

Ascarate Lake is entirely fed by wells that draw water from around 160 feet

underground, according to Tim Fulton, the county's director of parks and recreation. So, the county wants to dig new, deeper wells because they detected some phosphates in the lake water that come from fertilizer used on the park's nearby golf course and add aerators to the lake, Fulton said. The phosphates of Ascarate Lake, protecting existing are the likely source of nutrients that spur algae blooms, he noted.



- On Sept. 29, 1780, British spy John André, an accomplice of Benedict Arnold, was court-martialed, found guilty and sentenced to death by hanging. He wrote to Gen. George Washington asking to be executed by firing squad instead, which was considered a more "gentlemanly" death, but though Washington attempted to have him exchanged for Arnold, the original sentence was carried out on Oct. 2.
- 30, On Sept. 1918, President Woodrow Wilson gave a speech before Congress in which he supported a guarantee that women would be granted the right to vote. The House of Representatives approved a 19th constitutional amendment giving women suffrage, but Congress would not pass the amendment for another year.
- On Oct. 1, 1958, the American Express company issued its first charge card, made of purple paperboard, in the U.S. and Canada, to give traveling customers more flexibility.
- On Oct. 2, 1965, during a football game between the University of Florida Gators and the Louisiana State University Tigers, UF players tested a new sports drink

developed in the school's science labs to help them regain essential chemicals their bodies lost through sweating. The Gators won their match and the drink now known as Gatorade went on to make its investors wealthy.

- On Oct. 3, 2011, an Italian appeals court overturned the murder conviction of American exchange student Amanda Knox, who'd been found guilty of stabbing her British roommate, Meredith Kercher, to death in 2007. Imprisoned since her arrest, Knox flew back to the States the following day.
- On Oct. 4, 1970, singer Janis Joplin was found dead of an accidental heroin overdose in her Los Angeles hotel room after failing to attend a recording session. She was putting the finishing touches on the album titled "Pearl," that would prove to be the biggest hit of her career.
- On Oct. 5, 1892, the infamous Dalton Gang attempted a daylight robbery of two Coffeyville, Kansas, banks simultaneously. After someone recognized a member and spread word of the crime, the townspeople ran for their guns and surrounded the two banks, then took justice into their own hands, killing all but Emmett Dalton, who, incredibly, survived prison and eventually ended up as a Hollywood screenwriter.

Know the signs of senior abuse

Sometimes it takes watchful eyes to keep seniors safe. Whether it's physical, emotional or financial abuse, or lack of care or physical abuse. A neighbor who's had any other kind, those who come in contact with seniors can look for signs that all is not well.

In banking, if you spot a senior who seems distressed medicine or mail. and who repeatedly takes large sums of money out of an account (or changes his or her routine), that senior might to the National Center on Elder Abuse (ncea.acl.gov) or be a victim of abuse or a scam. (Seniors, don't use the drive-up teller window. Go inside so staff can get to know you. Sign a new signature card every six months so your Check eldercare.gov, or call 800-677-1116. You'll find handwriting sample is current.)

If you spot personality changes in a senior, the cause long-term care, nutrition... and abuse. might be physical – or it might be a result of abuse. Ask what's going on. 



Choice of hip replacement surgery comes down to trust

DEAR DR. ROACH: My husband is 72 years old and on a waiting list for a hip replacement due to severe

osteoarthritis. The surgeon he was referred to is quite young, has been performing anterior minimally invasive hip replacements for five years, and does about 250 per year. Originally we had asked to be referred to a different surgeon who has 30 years of experience, but we were told that older surgeons, although very



experienced, do not do this procedure. Instead, they tend to do what they were initially trained to do, which includes cutting through muscle and tendon to access the hip. Apparently this causes a lengthier recovery period. What are your thoughts on this? -D.M.

In general, I do not recommending telling a surgeon which specific type of surgery to perform. You place yourself in the surgeon's hands and expect to be treated to the best of their expertise. Depending on your particular issues, one type of surgery may be better than another, but only a surgeon can decide this.

I reviewed the published literature on minimally invasive surgery versus conventional surgery. Not everyone is a candidate for the minimally invasive procedure. There are some benefits to the minimally invasive surgery such as less postoperative pain, reduced hospital stay, and less blood

However, there has been no consistent benefit shown for infection rates and complications such as dislocation or fracture near the prosthesis. There also isn't evidence of any revision of the procedure. Some studies have suggested a higher rate of nerve injury with the minimally invasive procedure.

Since there are some short-term but no proven long-term benefits to the minimally invasive procedure, I advise you to find a surgeon you trust and listen to their recommendation for the right procedure in your husband's case.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have a couple issues with my bladder and a sleep aid. I am an 81-year-old male in fairly good health. I have a difficult time getting back to sleep after getting up to empty my bladder. My solution for this was to take a melatonin tablet after each trip back to bed. This seemed to help. However, I researched melatonin online and found that some people, my wife included, can get nausea and stomach cramps from using it. While this does not happen with me, I'm wondering if taking 3 mg per night could be harmful to me, given the reaction my wife gets. - J.T.M.

Although melatonin is generally safe, it can cause some side effects. In addition to the stomach cramps, people have reported vivid dreams or nightmares, short-term depression, dizziness, and headaches. A few people find the medication helpful enough that they are willing to live with these side effects, but many people will give up and try a different treatment for sleep.

If melatonin isn't causing you any side effects, then it is likely safe for you. Many people use melatonin, and although long-term safety has not been proven in trials, it is increasingly unlikely that any long-term adverse effects haven't been discovered.




